

Conditions of Entry at the Singapore Sports Museum

The Kallang Group Pte. Ltd. (the “**Company**”) as a venue owner is dedicated to providing a safe, comfortable and enjoyable environment for its patrons. In support of this, the following conditions of entry (“**Conditions of Entry**”) apply to entry for event, show, performance, attraction, exhibition or other activity (“**Event**”) held at the premises which patrons are entering (“**Venue**”). For certain Events these may be supplemented by additional specific terms and conditions, details of which will be printed on a patron’s ticket and/or available on the relevant Event page. If a patron does not consent to the T&Cs, the person must not enter the Venue. By entering the Venue, the patron consents to be bound by the T&Cs including the following Conditions of Entry.

1. Safety and Behaviour

- 1.1. At the point of entry and also whilst inside the Venue, patrons are required to:
 - 1.1.1. comply with the directions or announcements from the Company’s staff and any other requirements relating to access, order, behaviour and safety given by the Company or authorities;
 - 1.1.2. maintain safe, prudent and respectful behaviour at all times;
 - 1.1.3. refrain from shouting and to switch their mobile phones to silent mode in the exhibition galleries of the Venue. Younger visitors and children should use their quiet voices;
 - 1.1.4. be responsible for personal items. The Company will not be responsible for any damage to, loss or theft of a patron’s personal property;
 - 1.1.5. keep escape routes and corridors, landings and stairwells clear of obstruction caused by a patron’s personal property or any equipment brought to the Venue.
- 1.2. Any running, pushing or rough play in the Venue is prohibited.
- 1.3. Patrons acknowledge that some Events and associated activities can be dangerous.
- 1.4. Patrons entering the Venue do so at their own risk and assume all risk and liability for personal injury or death including that of any children under their care associated with attending the Event. The Company shall bear no liability for any personal injuries, health problems or death sustained at or after an Event, including directly or indirectly resulting from any existing medical condition.

2. Entry and Exclusion

- 2.1. Singaporeans and permanent residents are granted complimentary entry into the permanent exhibition galleries with a valid proof of identification. The Venue only accepts identification cards, valid passports or a valid Singapore driver’s license as proof of identification.
- 2.2. For all ticketed exhibitions, each patron must have a ticket to gain admission. Tickets are non-transferable.
- 2.3. Ticket holders holding a child or concession ticket must be entitled to use such a ticket held, and the Company reserves the right to request identification or other evidence of entitlement. Details of the entitlement requirements for concession/child tickets will be listed on the Event page at www.thekallang.com.sg.
- 2.4. The Company reserves the right to check identification of any ticket holder upon entry or once inside the Venue.
- 2.5. Venue re-entry is restricted except with a valid ticket.
- 2.6. The Company reserves the right at all times to refuse entry to or remove any person from the Venue. This includes, but is not limited to the following circumstances:
 - 2.6.1. ticket is damaged, defaced, forged or copied or not purchased from a Box Office or online at the official ticketing operator website;
 - 2.6.2. the presence of the person would be detrimental to or compromises safety at the Venue;
 - 2.6.3. person is deemed to be disorderly and/or intoxicated;
 - 2.6.4. person wearing or displaying commercial, political or other offensive signage or logos, except for official merchandise clothing worn in good faith;
 - 2.6.5. entry to the Venue or an area prohibited to the general public within the Venue was unauthorised or obtained illegally;
 - 2.6.6. persons who refuse to be inspected or submit their identification or belongings for inspection;
 - 2.6.7. person is found to be smoking within the Venue, unless it is a designated smoking area;
 - 2.6.8. dangerous situations or any other causes that will affect the safety of patrons; and
 - 2.6.9. person who breaches these Conditions of Entry.
- 2.7. No refund or compensation will be made under any of these circumstances.
- 2.8. The Company reserves the right to issue a banning notice which prohibits entry to the Venue for a specified period of time. The Company will refuse entry or remove from the Venue any person who has been issued with a banning notice.

3. Restricted / Prohibited Items

- 3.1. The following restricted/prohibited items are not permitted into the Venue:
 - 3.1.1. weapons, or resemblance of weapons, including but not limited to knives, firearms, blunt offensive objects/batons and those with sharp ends;
 - 3.1.2. fireworks/flares;
 - 3.1.3. laser pointers;
 - 3.1.4. illegal substances including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs;
 - 3.1.5. glassware or glass bottles;
 - 3.1.6. cans or spray cans;
 - 3.1.7. food and beverage including alcohol (mineral/bottled water is allowed inside the Venue);
 - 3.1.8. bags or luggage of dimensions larger than 35cm x 20cm x 30cm;
 - 3.1.9. items too large to be electronically screened;
 - 3.1.10. bicycles, skateboards, skates and scooters;
 - 3.1.11. helmets of any type;
 - 3.1.12. chairs/stools;
 - 3.1.13. animals (other than trained assistance dogs);
 - 3.1.14. musical instruments and noise makers including but not limited to drums, whistles, vuvuzelas, air horns and loud hailers without the prior consent of the Company;

- 3.1.15. projectile items which are reasonably considered by the Company as being able to cause injury, nuisance or offence to another person including balls, frisbees, rackets or similar objects;
- 3.1.16. banners or flags larger than 1m x 2m;
- 3.1.17. LED and fan boards larger than 42cm x 29.7cm (ie. A3 sized);
- 3.1.18. flag poles;
- 3.1.19. helium balloons or other inflatables;
- 3.1.20. glow/light sticks longer than 40cm;
- 3.1.21. tripods; monopods and selfie sticks;
- 3.1.22. remote control cars, drones or unmanned aerial vehicles; and
- 3.1.23. other items as determined by the Company that may cause injury or public nuisance.

4. Photographs, Images and Recording

- 4.1. Flash photography is restricted.
- 4.2. Non-commercial photography is permitted at the Venue provided that the photographs are for personal use.
- 4.3. Video and audio recording devices including camcorders and action cameras are prohibited. Tapes, films or other recordings may be destroyed.
- 4.4. Some Events may prohibit the use of any cameras. Please visit the relevant Event page at www.thekallang.com.sg for specific information of the Event.
- 4.5. If allowed, photographs taken within the Venue may be used only for private non-commercial purposes.
- 4.6. The use of any recording, data or image taken within the Venue without the Company’s consent for commercial gain, public advertisement, display or any other purpose, except for private non-commercial purpose, is prohibited.
- 4.7. Any person, who makes, reproduces or uses any recording, data or image for use prohibited under this clause 4 shall assign in writing all copyright and intellectual property rights to the Company or its assignees.
- 4.8. Equipment including but not limited to CCTV, film cameras and sound recording are present at the Venue. By entering the Venue and/or attending the Event, patrons consent to being filmed and recorded and for the Company and any assignees to use the patrons’ image, likeness and any sound recording for any media or other purposes including public transmission, advertising or promotional purposes, without payment or claim to copyright or intellectual property rights. Patrons consent to footage being shared with Singapore Police Force and authorities where necessary.

5. General Conditions

- 5.1. This is a non-smoking Venue.
- 5.2. The Company may postpone, cancel, interrupt or stop the use, or deny access to the Venue for any dangerous situation, maintenance works or any other causes without notice, without any compensation to the patrons.
- 5.3. Umbrellas are permitted into the Venue but should not be raised up for the comfort of others.
- 5.4. Strollers are permitted into the Venue. The Company shall bear no liability for any damages to the stroller within the Venue.
- 5.5. Objects and artefacts in the exhibition galleries or displayed outside the galleries within the Venue, are strictly not to be touched, unless stated otherwise. This is a general rule to be observed, as some objects may not be displayed in protective cases but as free-standing displays. When in doubt, please ask the gallery attendants or a Venue employee.
- 5.6. Patrons are prohibited from leaving their personal belongings unattended anywhere in the Venue.
- 5.7. No refund will be made under any circumstances, except at promoter’s discretion if the Event is postponed or cancelled, and then according to promoter’s refund policy. Conditions of refund are available at the Box Office.
- 5.8. Children under 12 years old must always be accompanied by a responsible person aged 18 years old or older.

6. Miscellaneous

- 6.1. The Company may hold liable for prosecution any person who breaches any of the above Conditions of Entry.
- 6.2. Please note the Company reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Entry without prior notice. The above Conditions of Entry may vary between events and may be reflected on the specific Event page via www.thekallang.com.sg.
